Allocation of items

1. The items of the agenda attributed by the General Assembly of the First Committee are listed in the First Report of the General Committee for the General Assembly of FAMUN (A(FAMUN)/11/250).

Work Programme

2. The draft of the Work Programme (see attachment) was prepared taking into account the Provisional Agenda of the eleventh ordinary session of the General Assembly of FAMUN (A(FAMUN)/11/250) and the availability of documentation.

Duration of speeches

3. The Committee suggests following the guideline recommended by the FAMUN General Committee to the FAMUN General Assembly in its first report (A(FAMUN)/11/250), in order to set a time limit of 1 minute for each of the Member States during the general debate in the First Committee. In this regard, the Committee encourages the Chairs to fully exercise their functions as defined in rule 13 of the rules of procedure.

Conference services and meeting arrangements

4. Taking into account the availability of conference services for the main committees of the General Assembly, seven meetings have been scheduled for the First Committee. Unless otherwise specified, seven meetings will be held: from 16:30 to 18:00 on September 3; from 09:00 to 11:00; from 11:30 to 13:00; from 15:00 to 17:00 on

September 4; from 9:00 to 11:00; from 11:30 to 13:00; from 15:00 to 17:00 on September 5, 2026. In this context, the Committee wishes to remind delegations that punctuality is of utmost importance in order to ensure effective organization and orderly work for the FAMUN.

Informal consultations

5. The Committee decides to use the first and second informal meetings to meet in the political groups of the Member States. These and subsequent informal meetings should serve to reach consensus on a draft resolution, as far as possible.
6. *The Bureau* can serve as, or designate, facilitators to contribute to the consensus process.
7. Some of the informal meetings assigned to the First Committee may be used for consultations chaired by *Bureau* members, facilitators, or other delegates. In accordance with established practice, informal consultations may be used to express general observations on proposals and adopt them *ad referendum*. All drafting will be done at the level of informal consultations.

Conclusion of the Committee's work.

8. Taking into account the number of meetings scheduled for the First Committee, the Committee sets a deadline of 5 September 2026 at 17:00 for the completion of its work, so that action on all draft resolutions can take place at the General Assembly Plenary at 09:30 on 6 September 2026.
